

MANIFOLD DOOR SIGNS

NFPA-99 requires that the Medical Gas Manifold room door have proper warning signs depending on what gases will be stored in the room. If there is any Nitrogen, Nitrous Oxide or Carbon Dioxide the door must have the following text,



**CAUTION. MEDICAL GASES.
NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAMES
ROOM MAY HAVE INSUFFICIENT
OXYGEN
OPEN DOOR AND ALLOW ROOM TO
VENTILATE BEFORE OPENING**

These signs have a self-adhesive backing and are 12" x 12" and include a block for emergency contact information.

If the room only contains oxygen or medical air, the warning sign has it's text,



**CAUTION. MEDICAL GASES
NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAMES**
These signs have a self-adhesive backing and are 12" x 12" and include a block for emergency contact information
